 emergencies. Suggestions for additional infrastructure for the cyclone shelter
 were made including extra water tanks and solar panels/battery bank to
 ensure operations if fuel availability diminishes. Peter also talked about
 rewiring and upgrading one of the generators for a more efficient operation,
 and the Radio Tower construction.
