MONDAY 12 OCTOBER TO WEDNESDAY 14 OCTOBER 2020

Residents are asked to neatly place hard waste at the front of their property **SATURDAY 10 OCTOBER** and **SUNDAY 11 OCTOBER** for collection by Council staff **Monday 12 OCTOBER** to **Wednesday 14 OCTOBER**.

Separate your items

To make collection easier, we ask that items are separated into groups with like-items. Leave a space between groups rather than bundling everything together. **Health and safety of Council staff is priority. Dangerous goods; oversized items or waste deposited in a dangerous or irresponsible manner will not be collected.**

Tips on safety when placing your items

- Ensure you place your items in a responsible way.
- Be aware of potential danger of any items placed on the road verge
- Be mindful about the safety of road users and pedestrians

Items that will NOT be accepted:

- Water tanks
- Metal/steel structures
- 44-gallon drums (complete)
- Ammunition, explosives, flares, fire extinguishers and gas bottles
- Liquid waste e.g. motor or cooking oil, chemicals, fuels and cans/tins containing paint
- Car bodies, vehicle parts, panels, tyres and batteries
- Trailers
- Asbestos
- Concrete, bricks, rocks, dirt, cement sheeting, plasterboard
- Ceramic tiles
- Business/commercial waste
- Green/organics grass clippings, weeds, branches
- Household or putrescible waste

Streets will be cleared one at a time and in the following order:

Wagait Tower Road, Forsyth Street, De Lissa Drive, Mungalo Road, Cox Drive, Erickson Crescent, Joseph Court, Vangemann Street, Winal Court, Brisbane Street, Kathleen Court, Dalmeny Road, Head Court, Baluria Road, Uhr Road, Pak Place, Bray Place, Boom Place, Harney Street, Dillon Place, Sachse Street, Milady Street, Massey Street.
