Registration in Wagait Shire will be free for the inaugural year (2020) and ongoing for dogs < 12 months old that are microchipped and desexed. Dogs < 6 months do not need to be registered.

Payment can be made in person at the Wagait Shire Council office or by completing the section below and posting the form to Wagait Shire Council, PMB 10, Darwin NT 0801, or email to council@wagait.gov.au.

If returning the form with payment by mail or email, please include copies of sterilisation certificate. Registration cannot be processed without the supporting documentation. A registration tag for your dog/s can be collected from the Council office or can be sent to your postal address with a receipt for payment.

RECIPROCAL REGISTRATION

Registration is annual and due on **1 September each year**, and is reciprocal with participating Top End Councils including; City of Darwin, City of Palmerston, Coomalie Community Council and Litchfield Council. This means that if you move to or from another participating Council during that year, your dog registration is recognised in that new local government area. Your name and contact details must be the same and proof of current and previous residence must be shown.
